MEET SCHEDULING PROCEDURES

A bid to host a Masters Meet is enclosed. Please use this procedure for scheduling Mich. Masters Swim Meets for the upcoming 1992-1993 season. If your club is interested in organizing a meet next Fall, Winter, or Spring, please follow directions on the form. The entire 1992-1993 schedule will be determined based on the information submitted on these forms.

1992 STATE MEET

190 swimmers participated in the State Meet at Saginaw Valley State University. 2 national records, 175 state records (93 women's and 82 men's) were broken during the course of the meet. Many thanks to Mike Bacigalupo, Bay City YMCA, and Saginaw Valley State University for the planning and execution of the meet. A facility in the Southeast region of the state (i.e. U of M or Eastern Michigan University) will be the site of the 1993 State Meet.

1992 MICHIGAN MASTERS AWARDS

The two annual awards, the Lawrence Award for best swimmer and the Chetrick Award for service to Michigan Masters, were presented during the State Meet. The Lawrence Award was given to Wally Dobler. Wally started swimming Masters in 1973 and in that time has made All-American status for 14 years and is the Michigan Masters current leader in that category. He was also the only swimmer in Michigan Masters in 1991 to have a 1st place time in both Short Course and Long Course National Top Ten Listings.

The Chetrick Awards went to George Newman. George has been involved with Michigan Masters since its inception in 1972. He has been Referee, Starter, and Stroke Judge at approximately 75% of all the local swim meets held in the history of Michigan Masters. He has been in charge of officiating at 12 state meets, 2 zone meets, and the 1979 Long Course Nationals held in Dearborn, Michigan.

The high point team trophy went to the South Oakland Seals. SOS won the women's, men's and combined categories.

1992 STATE MEMBERSHIP MEETING NOTES

REGISTRATION – A \$2.00 increase in registration at the state level was passed to cover increasing costs of administration. This is the first increase since Fall 1987. This will raise the state portion from \$8.00 to \$10.00.

AWARDS – Michigan Masters is changing the current medals. All existing stock of medals was used up at the state meet. Michigan Masters has ordered NEW MEDALS. People at the state meet that did not get their medals will have them mailed to them.

FITNESS COMMITTEE – An establishment of a fitness committee was passed to bring fitness programs to Michigan Masters. William Reid was appointed Fitness Chairman. He will be responsible for current set up and marketing.

MICHIGAN MASTERS SWIMMING MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT - SKIP THOMPSON

AT THE STATE MEMBERSHIP MEETING ON APRIL 4, 1992 AN INCREASE OF \$2.00 IN REGISTRATION WAS APPROVED TO COVER OUR BUDGETED EXPENSES FOR THE COMING 1993 YEAR. THIS IS AN INCREASE OF 25% (\$8.00 TO \$10.00) AT THE STATE LEVEL. THE USMS REGISTRATION FEE IS \$15.00 AND IF THIS DOES NOT INCREASE THE TOTAL REGISTRATION FEE FOR 1993 WILL BE \$25.00. MICHIGAN MASTERS TWO PRIMARY SOURCES OF REVENUE ARE REGISTRATION AND MEET FEES. THE AVERAGE FOR THESE TWO SOURCES OF REVENUES OVER THE PAST 4 YEARS HAS BEEN \$3000.00, AND \$1500.00, RESPECTIVELY. MICHIGAN MASTERS HAS BEEN STRUGGLING TO ACHIEVE THESE AVERAGES, ESPECIALLY REGISTRATION IN 1992.

WHAT ARE SOME OF THE MAJOR FACTORS AFFECTING US? WHAT CAN WE DO? WILL THINGS GET BETTER?

THERE ARE 5 MAJOR FACTORS THAT HAVE OR ARE AFFECTING MICH. MASTERS:

1. LOWER REGISTRATION THAN IN PREVIOUS YEARS.
2. LOWER MEET PARTICIPATION.
3. FEWER CLUBS WILLING TO PUT ON MEETS.
4. FEWER ORGANIZED MASTERS SWIM CLUBS THAN IN THE PAST YEARS.
5. NO ORGANIZED FITNESS PROGRAMS FOR FITNESS SWIMMERS.

WHAT CAN WE DO?

AT THE STATE MEMBERSHIP MEETING WE DISCUSSED ALL OF THE FACTORS ABOVE AND CAME UP WITH CHANGES TO IMPROVE EFFICIENCY AND EFFECTIVENESS. IN REGARD TO REGISTRATION, MICH. MASTERS IS TRYING TO IMPROVE COMMUNICATION BETWEEN THE STATE AND THE LOCAL MASTERS SWIM CLUBS AND UNATTACHED SWIMMERS. A MAJOR REASON WHY SWIMMERS DO NOT RE-REGISTER IS BECAUSE THEY DO NOT COMPETE IN MEETS FOR THAT YEAR. WITH THE ADDITION OF A FITNESS COMMITTEE, TO START UP SOME INTERESTING PROGRAMS, WE MIGHT RETAIN SWIMMERS WHO DO NOT COMPETE IN SWIM MEETS. SOME IDEAS THAT CAME UP AT THE MEETING WERE: "SWIM MICHIGAN" DISTANCE SWIMMING WHERE SWIMMERS CHART THEIR YARDAGE/MILEAGE TO DIFFERENT HISTORICAL LANDMARKS IN THE STATE OF MICHIGAN. ALSO JACKSON MASTERS SPONSORED A "CAN MEET" WHERE PEOPLE WOULD BRING A CAN OF FOOD TO ENTER. THE EVENTS WERE 25'S, 50'S, AND 100'S WITH NO SANCTION #, NO RULES, AND NO INSURANCE. THIS INTRODUCED A LOT OF PEOPLE TO THE CONCEPT OF MASTERS. AN EFFORT WILL BE MADE TO KEEP IN CONTACT WITH PEOPLE DO NOT RE-REGISTER.

WITH REGARDS TO MEET PARTICIPATION AND CLUBS WILLING TO PUT ON MEETS AN EFFORT HAS BEEN MADE TO INCLUDE ALL SWIMMERS FROM ALL OVER THE STATE AND ANY CLUB WANTING TO HOST A MEET. A BID FORM HAS BEEN ORGANIZED AND HOPEFULLY PAST MEET DIRECTORS, AND CLUBS INTERESTED IN HOSTING A MEET, WILL FOLLOW THE PROCEDURE. IN THE PAST 2 YEARS THIS HAS NOT BEEN HAPPENING. A SANCTIONS PACKET AND GUIDE, "HOW TO RUN A MEET" ARE AVAILABLE TO MEET DIRECTORS. MICHIGAN MASTERS MEETS ARE GEOGRAPHICALLY LOCATED IN ALL AREAS OF THE STATE SO SWIMMERS DON'T HAVE TO TRAVEL TO JUST MAJOR REGISTRATION AREAS TO SWIM. FOR THE PAST 7 YEARS THE STATE CHAMPIONSHIP MEET HAS ROTATED WITHIN THE STATE. MEET FEES HAVE BEEN AT THE LOW END OF THE COMPETITIVE STRUCTURE COMPARED TO THE REST OF THE U.S.. MICH MASTERS IS MOVING TO THE MIDDLE, THIS WILL BE AT THE DISCRETION OF THE MEET DIRECTOR.

THE LAST FACTOR AFFECTING MICHIGAN MASTERS IS FEWER ORGANIZED MASTERS SWIM CLUBS THAN IN PAST YEARS. A MAJOR REASON FOR THIS, AND THIS HAS HAPPENED IN MORE THAN ONE INSTANCE, IS A CLUB HAS ONE OR TWO MAJOR PEOPLE, EITHER A SWIMMER OR A COACH OR BOTH, WHO MOVE AWAY OR DROP OUT AND THE LOCAL MASTERS SWIM CLUB FALLS APART. THIS HAS HAPPENED WITH BOTH LARGE AND SMALL CLUBS. I WOULD LIKE TO SEE MORE PEOPLE INVOLVED WITH THE ADMINISTRATION OF THEIR CLUB SO THIS DOES NOT HAPPEN. AN EFFORT HAS BEEN MADE TO UPDATE "PLACES TO SWIM" TO USMS NATIONAL OFFICE AND MAJOR SWIM PUBLICATIONS "SWIM MAGAZINE" AND "FITNESS SWIMMER", WITH TWO CONTACT NAMES SO SWIMMERS CAN BE UPDATED AS TO WHERE TO WORK OUT AND WHAT CLUBS ARE AVAILABLE.

WILL THINGS GET BETTER? YES! LET'S PULL TOGETHER AND DO IT. WITH SOME OF THE CHANGES MADE AND PROGRAMS THAT ARE BEING INITIATED I BELIEVE WE ARE ON THE RIGHT TRACK. ONE LAST POINT, I WOULD LIKE TO THANK EVERYONE (OFFICERS, MEET DIRECTORS, COACHES AND VOLUNTEERS) THAT HAVE CONTRIBUTED TO THE SUCCESS OF MICHIGAN MASTERS.

Top-10 Times and Records

Top-10 times and records may only be accepted from sanctioned or approved meets. The conditions for sanctions and approvals are given in Part Two of the USMS rule book. All meets on the official Michigan Masters schedule meet these conditions.

You may achieve top-10 times and records in a USS meet, but only if the meet is approved. Follow these steps to secure an approval for USS meets held in Michigan:

1. Obtain a copy of the meet announcement. To participate in USS meets, you must be registered with USS and must have achieved the relevant time standards.
2. Ask the meet director to request a USMS approval from Gail Dummer, 3100 Scarborough, Lansing, MI 48910. Because USS and USMS essentially follow the same rules, this approval is almost automatic. Also ask the meet director to print the USMS approval number on the meet results.
3. Following the meet, submit a copy of the meet results to the Michigan Masters top-10 and records chairman, Bob Isbister, 48021 Colony Farm Circle, Plymouth, MI 48170.



The Top Ten Chairman from each LMSC should mail to me their short course yards top ten results for the '91-'92 season which just concluded. Please use exactly the same format you provide to Walt Reid for National Top Ten consideration. I prefer to work with computer disk, so if you send Walt a disk, just make a copy for me. I use IBM compatible, either 3.5" or 5 1/4. Send to me by June 1. I will compile and publish by July 1. Awards to the top swimmer in each age group will be sent to the LMSC's for distribution.

It has been suggested that in the future we limit eligibility to only those swimmers registered in our zone. Please be prepared to discuss this at Convention. Meanwhile, we will use your Top Ten lists as you provide to Walt.

Remember, the long course season runs through September, and the short course meters season runs through December.

Swimmers had to be observed whilst providing a urine sample, which was then retained by the officials for subsequent analysis. Swimmers should beware at future meets and be sure they are aware of any 'forbidden' substances taken as part of prescribed medication."

OCEANA -- Kathy Casey bid "farewell" as Oceana Zone was split (she is now Northwest Zone Rep).

LOCAL TRANSPORTATION: For airport to motel transportation, taxi service is available on the baggage pickup level (approximate fare to Fife for one person is \$25.00). Those preferring to use a shuttle service may call Shuttle Express for reservations 622-1424 (Approximately \$18.00 for one person from Sea-Tac to Fife).

A free shuttle service has been arranged between the Royal Coachman, Portage Inn, Comfort Inn (Fife) and La Quinta Inn (Tacoma) to the pool from Wednesday, August 19 to Sunday, August 23, 1992 (see map at back of brochure). Transportation from all motels north of the Aquatic Center is available via a ride on public (Metro) bus transportation with a connection to the shuttle service at the South Federal Way Park and Ride. Shuttle service schedules will be posted at each shuttle stop, and a schedule will be included in the registration packet you receive when you check in.

RENTAL CARS: The following nationwide car rental companies service Seattle-Tacoma International Airport: Alamo, Avis, Budget, Dollar, General, Hertz, National and Thrifty.

WEATHER: August weather is typically sunny, with daytime temperatures in the 70's and 80's. However, there are frequently partly cloudy skies with scattered showers. The Seattle area is known for its liquid sunshine, so bring an umbrella and jacket for your journeys out-of-doors. Evening temperatures can drop into the 50's in some areas (especially closer to Puget Sound).

FOOD CONCESSIONS: Food concessions will be available at the Aquatic center from 7:00 AM to the conclusion of the meet Thursday through Sunday.

EMERGENCY NUMBER: Weyerhaeuser King County Aquatic Center, (206) 296-4444 for emergencies only. Pay phones are available for other calls.

MESSAGES: For your convenience, a message board will be posted in the foyer of the main entrance to the Aquatic Center Wednesday-Sunday, August 19-23.

MEDICAL: There will be an ACLS-equipped ambulance with paramedics on site during all warm-up and competition hours. St. Francis Community Hospital is one mile from the pool.

MASSAGE: We are planning to have professional massage therapists available at the meet. There will be a charge for this optional service.

T-SHIRTS, ETC.: Championship T-Shirts, as well as other swimming supplies and souvenirs will be available in the lobby of the Aquatic Center.

PARKING: There is parking available at the north and south ends of the Aquatic Center. In addition, there is parking at the Little League Fields three blocks away from the pool. RV's are welcome to park at the pool. Hookups are not available. **NO TENT CAMPING IS ALLOWED.**

LOCKERS/SHOWERS: There are limited numbers of lockers and showers available. Please plan accordingly.

FACILITY / OPERATIONS: The Weyerhaeuser King County Aquatic Center is a world-class indoor facility with a 50-meter x 25-yard competition pool, a 19 x 25-yard diving tank, as well as an instructional pool with 3, 25-yard lanes. The competition pool has eight nine-foot wide lanes and is 9 to 10.5 feet deep. Deck level concrete surge gutters further minimize wave action. An Omega timing system is linked to a state-of-the-art scoreboard located at one end of the competition pool which provides read-outs for all eight lanes and is easily seen from all areas of the pool.

Spectators Welcome. Seating is available for 2400 competitors and spectators. There is no admission charge. Only coaches, officials and competitors will be allowed on the pool deck.

DIRECTIONS TO THE AQUATIC CENTER:

- a) NORTH BOUND I-5 OR SOUTH BOUND I-5: Take exit 142-B. You will then be going west on S 348th. Continue West past Pacific Highway S (Highway 99) and past 1st Ave S (Note: 348th becomes SW Campus Drive after crossing 1st Ave S). The pool is on your right about 1/2 mile past 1st Ave. S.
- b) WEST BOUND HIGHWAY 18 (from North Bend): continue west on Highway 18 into Federal Way. Highway 18 becomes S 348th after crossing underneath I-5. Follow the instructions for a).

OFFICIALS/RULES: USMS RULES WILL BE STRICTLY ADHERED TO. Rule books may be obtained for \$6 from the USMS NATIONAL OFFICE, Two Peter Avenue, Rutland, MA 01543.

The Head Referees for the meet are Ron VanPool and Neville Johnson. Mr. VanPool and Mr. Johnson are Nationally Certified Referees through US Swimming. They have both served as Chief Judges at USS National Championship Meets. Mr. VanPool is on the USS National Officials Committee, and on the Championship Meet Conduct Committee, and has served as Meet Referee for USS National Championships.

Experienced officials will be provided by Pacific Northwest Swimming Association of United States Swimming and Pacific Northwest Association of Masters Swimmers. Most of these officials have worked at USS National and zone meets. All officials will be certified by a United States Swimming Local Swim Committee.

ELIGIBILITY: The meet is open to any registered USMS swimmer 19 years or older as of August 23, 1992. (Age as of the last day of the meet determines your age group for the entire meet.) Entries marked "pending" in place of a 1992 USMS registration number will not be accepted. Contact your local registrar to register. A copy of your current USMS registration card must accompany your meet entry.

Foreign swimmers are welcome. Entries must include a copy of your International Travel Permit and fees in U.S. dollars.

AFFILIATION: Each swimmer and the club that they represent must be registered in the same LMSC. If there is any question about affiliation, the swimmer will be entered as "unattached". Masters rules state, "A swimmer's affiliation, as stated on the entry form, if valid as of the first day of the meet, will apply throughout the meet, except that swimmers may unattach at any time."

SAFETY GUIDELINES FOR ALL POOLS WILL BE DRAWN UP PRIOR TO THE MEET AND WILL BE HANDED TO EACH SWIMMER AT REGISTRATION. THIS WILL INCLUDE THE USE OF "ONE WAY" SPRINT LANES AND LIMITED STARTS FROM THE BLOCKS. DIVING WILL ONLY BE PERMITTED FROM DESIGNATED SPRINT LANES. OTHERWISE, FEET-FIRST ENTRY IS TO BE USED. ADHERE TO THE SAFETY GUIDELINES; THEY ARE FOR YOUR PROTECTION.

ENTRY PROCEDURE: Use the official entry or a legible copy (both sides with no parts missing) and follow instructions carefully. A checklist has been provided as a means of double-checking for accuracy and completeness. **ENCLOSE A PHOTOCOPY OF YOUR USMS REGISTRATION CARD OR INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL PERMIT.** To verify receipt of entry forms, enclose a self-addressed stamped envelope or post card. Keep a photocopy of your completed entry and bring it with your entry receipt to the meet. "No Time" entries for swimming events will not be permitted.

ENTRY DEADLINE: ENTRIES MUST BE IN THE HANDS OF THE MEET DIRECTOR NOT LATER THAN THURSDAY, JULY 16, IN ORDER TO BE ACCEPTED. All entries not in compliance with the above restrictions will be returned to the sender. Allow sufficient time for delivery.

FAX ENTRIES: Entries may be faxed during the month of July, only. A \$10 service fee will be charged. An entry confirmation card will be sent. The fax # is (206)941-2795. The fax machine will be on line from July 1, 1992, until 11:59 PM July 16, 1992 (PACIFIC DAYLIGHT TIME). VISA and Mastercard will be accepted for FAX ENTRIES ONLY.

ENTRIES FOR INDIVIDUAL EVENTS: Individuals may enter and swim in six (6) individual events, maximum of three (3) per day, not including relays. A list of events follows. **NOTE:** a swimmer may enter only ONE of the distance (800 or 1500 free) events on Thursday, August 20, NOT BOTH. Do not enter more than the allowed number of events.

If, in the opinion of the USMS National Championship Committee, the meet is too large to be run in an efficient manner, each entry will be reduced to five (5) events, as described in the 1992 USMS Rules and Regulations. If entering six (6) events, indicate clearly with an asterisk (*) the least desired event. If the least desired event is not indicated with an asterisk (*), the Entry Chairman will decide which event to drop. There will be no refunds for the dropped event. "No Time" entries will not be accepted.

FEES: The entry fee is \$13.00 (surcharge) per swimmer, plus \$4.00 per individual event, and \$8.00 per relay (\$12.00 for deck-entered). The surcharge also applies to swimmers participating only in relays. (See below for relay information). Fees must be sent with the official entry form. An entry will not be considered complete until the check has cleared the bank. If there is any question about a check, full cash payment in U.S. dollars will be required before the entrant is allowed to swim. Fees must be in U.S. dollars, by check or money order. **DO NOT SEND CASH.** Make checks for entries payable to PNA MASTERS SWIMMERS. Credit cards are not accepted for mailed entries.

SEEDING: All individual events of 200 meters and less will be pre-seeded slowest to fastest within each age group; the slowest full heat within each age group will swim first. Partial heats may be combined. If, in any age group, there are not enough swimmers for a complete heat, all swimmers in that age group will be seeded in adjacent lanes. The following events will be deck-seeded slowest to fastest, regardless of age: 400/800/1500 M freestyle, and 400 M IM. The slowest heats will swim first.

SCHEDULE OF EVENTS: Individual events will be held for each of the following age groups: 19-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70-74, 75-79, 80-84, 85-89, 90-94 and 95+.

Women's events are odd-numbered; Men's events are even-numbered.

SCRATCHES: Any swimmer who fails to report to the proper lane in the correct heat of his/her event shall be scratched from that event. He/she may not swim that event at another time.

Use the official relay entry form or a legible photocopy of the entire form. **Deck entries for relays will be accepted only on Wednesday, August 19, at the relay table in the registration area from 10:00 AM until 9:00 PM.** Only relay representatives designated on the relay entry form may deck enter relays. (No deck entries for individual events will be accepted for this meet.) The entry fee for relays on or before Thursday, July 16, 1992, will be \$8.00 per relay. The entry fee for deck-entered relays will be \$12.00 per relay. **ALL RELAY SWIMMERS (for pre-entered or deck-entered relays) must have entered the meet and paid the \$13.00 surcharge by July 16, 1992.** (See relay entry form.)

RELAY AGE GROUPS: 76+, 100+, 120+, 160+, 200+, 240+, 280+, and 320+.

RELAY ELIGIBILITY: Each relay swimmer must be at least 19 years of age (as of August 23, 1992), possess a current USMS registration card and be affiliated with the same Masters club as the other three members of the relay. The club and swimmers must all be registered by the same LMSC. Unattached swimmers may not swim relays.

RELAY ENTRY TIMES: Submit a reasonable estimate or an actual achieved time for each relay entered. "No Time" entries will not be accepted. If you are entering more than one relay in an age group, designate "A", "B", "C", etc. Relays will be deck-seeded.

RELAY ENTRY LIMIT: Competitors may swim in, at most, four (4) relay events, each event only once. The relay event limit is in addition to the individual event limit; six individual plus four relay events per swimmer are allowed.

MIXED RELAYS: These relay teams must be composed of two women and two men, who may swim in any order.

RELAY REPRESENTATIVE: Please designate one person as a relay representative on the front of the relay entry form. This person is responsible for deck entering any relays, picking up, filling out, and returning all of his/her relay cards by NOON on the day of each relay and picking cards up again prior to the relays.

The procedure is as follows:

1) If you are deck-entering relays, do so on Wednesday, August 19, between 10:00 AM and 9:00 PM.

2) Pick up relay card(s) any time from the first day of the meet at the relay table, but they must be handed back in by NOON on the day of the relay, thereby declaring entry.

RELAY TEAMS NOT HANDING CARDS BACK IN BY NOON THE DAY OF THE RELAY WILL BE SCRATCHED. Seeding will be done at this time. Lane assignments will be posted on the deck level, and in the main lobby of the pool area.

3) After the announcement that relays have been seeded, pick up cards for the lead swimmers to take to the blocks.

4) At some point before the start of the race, the back of the relay card **MUST** be filled out with the following:

- Name of each swimmer as it appears on USMS registration card,
- Age of each swimmer as of the last day of the meet,
- Sex of each swimmer for mixed relays, and
- Name of the lead-off swimmer.

Failure to present the head lane timer with a written list of relay swimmers shall prevent such team from competing. Fill out the cards properly and LEGIBLY.
