Masters.


David Shepherd

This year the Lawrence Award was awarded to David Shepherd for outstanding performances from 1991 through 1993. A few of David's accomplishments are as follows: 5 National Championships at the 1993 USMS Long Course Nationals in Minneapolis, 5 First Place finishes in th 1993 LC Top Ten, All American Swimmer in '91,'92 &'93 and

American Swimmer in '91,'92 &'93 and Long Distance All American in 1993. He also has set 17 state records in '92 & '93 that are still standing. He was the 1992 YMCA National Champion in the 500 & 1650 free and the 200 fly, as well as finishing 2nd in the 800 free at the '92 World Championships. Great swimming Dave and good luck in the future.

he Chetrick Award went to Bob Isbister for his service to the LMSC from 1987-94. Some of Bob's accomplishments are as follows: He has been the meet director of the Brighton meet from 1988 through '94, this being the largest meet outside of the State meet. He acted as Assistant Meet Director of the 1990 Zone meet and Co-Meet Director of the Dearborn LC meet, from '88 through'91.

In the article, Wally stated two things that seem to ring true for many Masters swimmers. First was in response to setting two records in the Grand Rapids meet in the 60-64 age group. He said, "Records are there for the taking if you want to work to get them." The two records that he broke had stood, respectively, since 1979 and 1988. They were the 50 vd Butterfly, with a time of :28.31, breaking the old record of :30.84 and the 100 vd fly at 1:04.92 vs. the old of 1:07.92. # LMSC Has Growth Spurt!

he 1994 swimming season for Michigan Masters has been a season for growing. Most of our meets had more participation than last year, including the State Meet which topped out at 313 this year. Making it the largest State Meet in the history of Michigan Masters Swimming. Last year we had 250 swimmers at State. This is the second year of seeing our state registration on the INCLINE after a decline which began in 1988.

So far this year, we have 473 registrations, well on our way to our goal of 500. At the time of the State Meet we were 16% ahead of last year's registrations at the same time. If we continue at that rate, we should top out at 524, just above the count for 1988.

Meanwhile, USMS registrations nationwide are on the rise. In fact the USMS Registration Committee is ready to grandly acknowledge to 30,000th swimmer to register. The '93 USMS registration count was 28,108 and they are projecting 30,918 registrants in '94.

## Michigan Swimming Meet Circuit

ver wondered who attended the most meets? Ever wondered who scores the most points over the winter meet season? This program will recognize the swimmers whom we see weekend after weekend on the blocks.

Beginning with the first Michigan meet in the fall of '94 and ending with the last Michigan meet before State, we will log the scores of all Michigan Masters Swimmers who sign up for the circuit. Swimmers will score 5 points for each first place finish, 3 points for second and 1 point for a third place finish. (Maximum of 4 swim permitted per meet.) For attending smaller meets or NEW meets (Grand Rapids Jr. College, Springs, Rockford, Harbor Kentwood ) swimmers will score ten extra points. We will announce the scores and winners (by age group) at the 1995 State Meet at Rockford. Age group winners will get Michigan Medals, "T-Shirts", Cap or Towel. (I want a CHOICE here; see swimmers response card attached.) Swimmers can sign up for the circuit beginning with the Fall Newsletter. The sign-up period will END with the Lansing Meet (or whatever meet is in December if Lansing doesn't run their meet). Please fill out and send in the swimmer response card with your suggestions for awards for the circuit as well as suggestions about the program.

# Nationals Network

At the Annual Membership meeting, at the State Meet, which was attended by 54 swimmers it was shown that those in attendance would be behind a bid for having the 1996 Masters' Long Course National Championships held at the University of Michigan. Even though this event is 2 years away, we need to begin thinking about where all of the support will come from. Below is a general (& preliminary) list of committe descriptions. Please take time to look it over and think about the way in which you (and your family) can best support this event.

In the fall newsletter, there will be more information and we will ask for you to let us know by mail or fax, just how you can help.

- 1. Registration Entry: Responsible for coordinating the publication & distribution of meet brochures & entry forms. Receipt and review of entries & will work with the Data Entry Committee on meet entries.
- 2. Registration Meet: Coordinate large support staff to run check-in (meet, distance events and relays). Will work with Meet Condiments Committee to develop the complimentary meet packets.
- 3. Officials: Coordinate recruitment and scheduling of all meet officials and timers.
- 4. Worker Hospitality: Coordinate recruitment and scheduling of all runners in addition to the staffing and management of the hospitality room for officials & volunteers during the course of the meet. Work with Hospitality Procurement Committee.
- 5. Transportation: Responsible for coordination of a shuttle service from local hotels to the pool as well as from Natatorium to Fuller Pool (the warm-up facility).
- 6. Housing: Responsible for all contact with Meet Headquarters facility and all possible housing sites, developing a list of alternate accommodations, maps, restaurant listings, also coordinating meeting sites.
- 7. Hospitality Procurement: Contact and arrange for hospitality supplies for the Worker hospitality room. Coordinate with Worker Hospitality.
- 8. Facilities Support Services: Responsible for recruiting and coordinating security, parking and Medical Staff and working with the pool staff to ensure set-up and tear-down as well as coordinating communication for on-site personnel.
- 9. Publications / Programs: Responsible for organizing the sale of ads and layout of heat sheets (coordinating with Data Entry Committee) and heat sheet sales to non-participants. As well as, coordinating a daily publication of the day's events during the meet.

- 10. Hospitality / Foreign Visitors: Responsible for an opening ceremony, info booth, message center and distribution of daily news. Coordinate basic necessities for foreign visitors.
- 11. Publicity: Contact State and Local media regarding the meet, supply daily results and updates. Follow-up after meet.
- 12. **Meet Condiments:** Put together the contents of the complimentary meet packets. Solicit vendors / contributors for printed info and "give aways". Coordinate with Registration Meet Committee for distribution and Facilty Director for information about on-site vendors.
- 13. Special Events: Responsible for planning and coordinating "Swimmer Social" or other special events which would take place during the week.
- 14. Awards / Souvenirs: Responsible for the developement of the meet logo; souvenir and award manufacture, including collection of bids for production and distribution of awards and souvenirs at the meet.
- 15. Michigan Relays: Will put together the relay teams for the Michigan Team and coordinate those teams throughout the meet.
- 16. Meet Management: Coordinate with Facility Manager and staff to oversee and troubleshoot (all areas, as necessay) during the duration of the meet.




